Terms and Conditions

1. Payment and confirmation

We will send your Confirmation of Booking within 10 working days. If you DO NOT hear from us within that time, please contact us immediately.

2. Cancellations

- You must contact us in writing to cancel a holiday.
- If you cancel after the full payment is due you are liable for the full cost of the holiday.
- The deposit is non-refundable.

3. Please inform us

In order to ensure that we have appropriate staff and facilities to meet your child's needs you should inform us of any health issues, disability, special or behavioural issues which may affect your child while on holiday.

4. Behaviour

We reserve the right to send home any child whose behaviour is compromising their own or others' safety or adversely affecting the enjoyment and well-being of others. In these circumstances we expect you to collect your child. You will be liable for any expenses incurred in returning the child home.

NOTE: We also reserve the right to refuse any booking.

5. Parental consent

It is understood that by signing the Booking Form you are giving permission for your child/ward to take part in the activities listed, as well as the general activities such as swimming, indoor and outdoor games, crafts and the Christian teaching on offer at each holiday.

6. Understanding activity risks

Many of our Holidays include activities that your child may not have participated in before. There will always be some real risk involved in these. We do all we can to reduce the risks whilst preserving the purpose and benefits of the activity. General Information

About the Christian Faith - As well as providing an excellent residential experience, Scripture Union also promotes the Christian faith. Each evening has two daily sessions for worship, Bible and prayer. There is also a teaching session every evening which is aimed at all ages. Where possible, some members will share a witness before the Service. However, children and young people of any faith or none are welcome at SU Holidays.

What to bring - A list of items to bring with your Confirmation of Booking. At some holidays you'll have a shopping bag out to other necessary equipment is necessary.

Programme - Where necessary and where possible we will implement the programme as published in the centre, where necessary we might make alterations should circumstances make this necessary, for example, weather conditions.

If we have to cancel a holiday - If it becomes necessary to cancel a particular holiday, the full amount paid will be refunded.

Photographs - Sometimes photographs and video are taken on all Holidays and used in SU publicity materials and on our website. Children and young people over 12 years of age have the right to opt out for themselves. If they want their images to be taken and used, we will make the clear to all the key participants and all responsible workers. If you have an objection to images of your child under 12 years being used for our purposes please box the appropriate box on the Booking Form. Images will not be made available to any other parties.

What about safety and supervision? - In the brochure you will find someone's name attached to each holiday. These are the Team Leaders who are either SU Staff or volunteers who are carefully selected for their backgrounds, abilities and experience. We ensure an enhanced awareness of all risks annually for volunteer Team Leaders at SU Holidays, as well as essential out-of-hours national selector and medical support services.

The Team Leader works to draw together a team of volunteers with different skills and qualifications, so that we can deliver the safe, caring and high quality programme you would expect at an SU Holiday. These volunteers are selected via a careful vetting and selection process, which includes checking Enhanced Disclosure checks on regular basis. All volunteers are given training and work within our safe environment. We mainly employ staff and adults by young people, some are SU employees, but most are volunteers who give their own time and contribute to their own costs in order to run SU Events. Everyone is placed in a special group under the immediate care of an adult leader. Activities such as sailing, kayaking and swimming are supervised by leaders who have obtained appropriate nationally recognised qualifications. All the minutes we used have been submitted. SU Events have an excellent safety record, which was awarded to us.

What about insurance? - SU Scotland events are covered by Public Liability insurance. We strongly recommend that you take out insurance to cover belongings, personal accident or illness you may need to carry. We will send you details of a competitively priced policy with your Confirmation of Booking. Please note that to be covered for our details, you should take out insurance as soon as possible after your booking is confirmed.

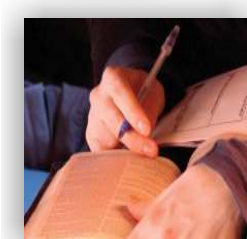
What about health? - Please tell us later for your child by completing the basic health details requested on the Booking Form. It is particularly helpful to show details of any allergies or special dietary requirements. A more detailed health form will be sent to you with other information before the event. It should be completed with details of emergency contacts, medication and sent WITH you to the event. In the event of any serious illness or emergency, we will contact the parents or guardian of the child using the contact number given as per the health form. If all other emergency contacts, professional medical help is sought. Parents should provide details of any medication required by their child and sign the form. On holiday, these medicines are kept and administered by the designated team member unless advised otherwise. The day, e.g. weekend number.

What about young people with special needs? - Young people with special needs are welcome at SU Holidays. Please contact us for advice and we will endeavour to find a suitable event. This includes young people whose first language is not English.

Are there any rules? - Yes - these have to be followed in order to ensure the safety of all. For example, campers may not leave the site without the permission of the overall Team Leader and swimming or outdoor games are only permitted under qualified supervision. Smoking and drinking drugs are not permitted. Alcohol is supplied between 12:00 and 18:00.

What about mobile phones? - At a number of sites there is poor or no reception. Mobile phone coverage is not guaranteed. Phones are available because of the high cost of phones being lost, damaged or misused. If your child has a mobile phone, it should be in a secure place and made available for use on a mutually convenient time of day. This also applies to camera phones, so it may be necessary to bring a separate camera for general use.

Any complaints? - If there is any problem during an event, we would like to know as soon as possible so that we can do our utmost to put it right. Please ask your child to mention it to the camp leader in the first instance. If the problem is not resolved by your satisfaction, please contact us either in writing or by phone as soon as possible. Scripture Union Scotland has a written complaints procedure that is available on request. We also have been to the ways of these on events even better. Please check how your centre is.
